

LCPN CHURCHPLANTERS EXPECTATIONS FORM

LCPN Equips churchplanters who assist Churches/ Denominations accomplish their church planting mandate. The major role of LCPN’s church planters is to partner the Church in a church planting assignment promising to deliver in the following services:

1. Evangelism, follow ups and discipleship.
2. Gather disciples for midweek and Sunday services
3. Develop leaders who will lead the assembly with him.
4. Nature fundamental groups existing in the new church plant such as; women, men, youth, juniors, music, and prayer groups.

A church planter commissioned to a place where evangelism activities has already been done, follow up and member retention becomes a fundamental responsibility of the church planter.

The church planter must demonstrate competence in gathering new believes and naturing them as described above.

Results of productive progress is measured based on the percentage of members coming to fellowship and active in the new church plant; a fifty percent retention is a significant mark of a job well-done. In as far as we leave all church development/ growth to God, we leave all the responsibility to the church planter to do his/ her part to the best possible ability.

Discernment of progress and the next step to take is done by both the denomination’s responsible authority and LCPN leadership. Therefore, periodic evaluation of progress and follow up activities are done.

The churchplanters should keep weekly progress records showing activities, number of disciples engaged in meetings outcomes.

The growth level of the new church plant will determine the time a church planter will stay in a single place/ accept in a case where a pre-agreed time is set.

Every LCPN commissioned church planter should operate based on the framework provided by the responsible church denomination; doctrine, principles, liturgy, and procedures. Any conflict of interest should be communicated to LCPN for engagement.

LCPN gives a church planter a working allowance agreed with the church planter and the responsible denomination in advance.

The responsible denomination may choose to provide other services based on the Church’s discretion and ability.
